BYI Eagles Nest and Family Expected Behavior & Participation Contract

Our Goals:

We will succeed if we create an environment where everyone gets to be who they are. To do this we will need to maintain certain boundaries so that fun times are fun for everyone and more serious times are shared by everyone.

Our Expectations:

Be responsible: Be on time at 3:00 and leave at 5:00*. *Please no early pick-ups, unless special arrangements have been worked out earlier with our Coordinator.

- Clean up after yourself before going home.
- Everyone present at our Eagles Nest is expected to participate in a variety of enrichment choices and activities.
- Important Adult NOTE: If your child(ren) will not attend a session on a Tuesday, you need to send in a note from home or you must contact the school office at 533-8916 before 2:00 pm with pick-up information. ALSO, Please contact Mrs. Debbie before at her email or cell of absences, with any instructions for pick-up, etc. before 1:30 if possible. Also, if your child is absent three sessions in a row (exceptions: Dr. and Dentist appts.) they will be asked to leave if another youth is on the wait list to participate. This will be decided together.

Be respectful: Always treat fellow youth, visitors, adults, volunteers, and any guest speakers and musicians with dignity and respect.

- Do not physically or verbally abuse others. This means that under no circumstances should you bully, hit, gossip about, throw something at, or make fun of another person.
- Taking another youth or adult's property is unacceptable unless express permission has been given to you by the owner of the object (i.e. cell phones, etc.)
- All cell phones/iPods/electronic devices should be turned off and placed in the locker prior to all activities, unless otherwise stated.

Be safe: At no time should a youth wander off or leave the classrooms or premises without adult supervision or prior permission.

Consequences for Misbehavior

The consequences for misbehavior outlined below aim to exemplify grace and forgiveness. It is our goal that any student who receives any offense learns from it and returns to Eagles Nest with a clean slate. We desire to have all students participating in all activities and will not hold prior offenses against students who have already completed the consequences for such (assuming that a pattern does not emerge) – students are held accountable for their behavior, but not condemned.

Consequences for Offenses:

1st Offense: The student will receive a verbal warning.

2nd Offense: The student will be pulled aside by the Director/leader to discuss the offense with a time out if needed.

3rd Offense: The student will be pulled aside by the Director/leader and will be asked to call his/her parents, explain why they are calling (i.e. what actions got them into trouble), and ask to be picked up immediately. At this time, the student will receive advance warning that the next offense will result in suspension from Eagles Nest for 1-2 weeks.

4th Offense: The student and his/her parent(s) will be notified that the student will not be allowed to return to EN for 1-2 weeks (depending on the severity of prior offenses) to think about their behavior. Students who reach 4th Offense multiple times may lose privileges including, but not limited to, EN, single day events and/or field trips. Additionally, students who reach 4th Offense multiple times may also be subject to required meetings with the Coordinator, parent meetings, and/or dismissal from EN.

The EN Coordinator reserves the right to determine the severity of misbehavior and may choose to skip or modify any of the above stated consequences.
